Grace River Foursquare Church is a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt nonprofit religious organization. Where the funds came from

The church received **\$102,692.00** in 2025. That amount divides into two funds, which serve different purposes and are tracked separately.

The difference between the two funds

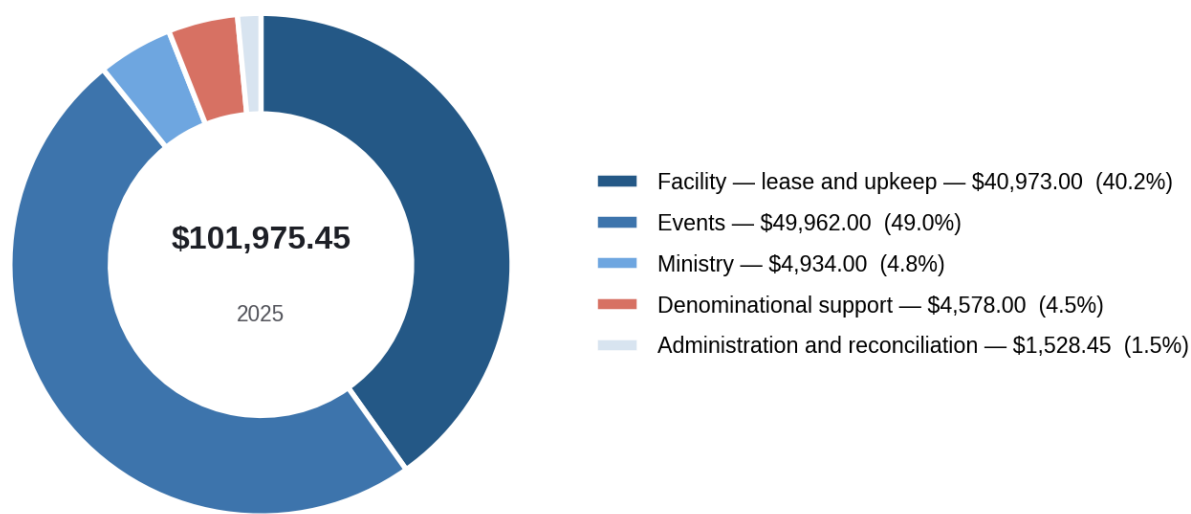
The tithes and offerings fund sustains the ordinary life of the church: the building lease, the utilities, the courses, pastoral care, and our support to the denomination. It is the money the church applies freely to its mission.

The restricted fund holds gifts given for a specific purpose — a mission trip, a district gathering, a designated campaign. That money can only be applied to what it was given for, and so it was. In 2025 we received \$52,171.00 and applied \$49,962.00; the remaining \$2,209.00 stays tied to its purpose.

How every dollar was used

The church applied **\$101,975.45** in 2025.

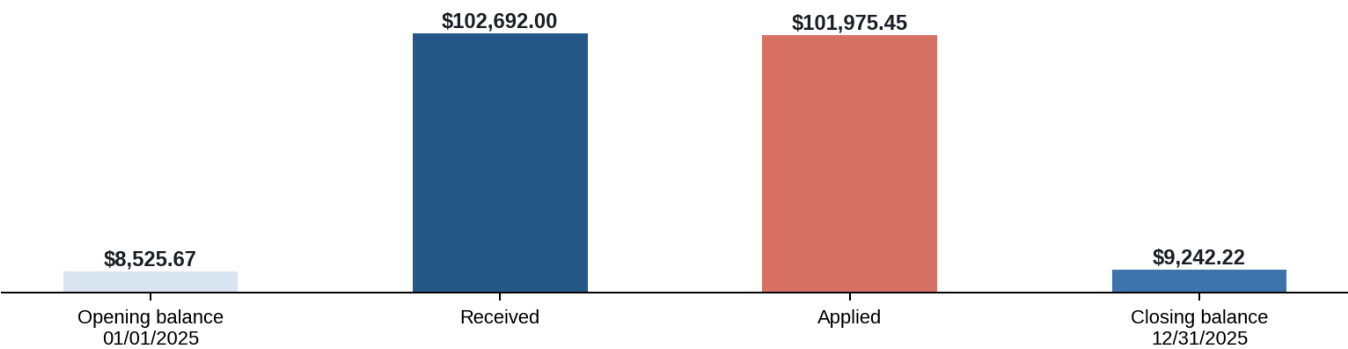

What these figures say

- **The building is the church's fixed cost.** Lease and upkeep totaled \$40,973.00 — it is what makes weekly gathering, the courses, and community life possible.
- **Events were funded by the restricted fund.** The \$49,962.00 applied corresponds to money received for that purpose, not to funds drawn from the church's operations.
- **Denominational support is 10% of tithes.** The church passes ten percent of tithe income to The Foursquare Church. On \$45,779.00 in tithes, that support was \$4,578.00.

The year closes

More came in than went out. The church ended 2025 with more cash than it started with.

Governance

- Financial statements are presented to the Members' Assembly for review and approval.
- Monthly financial reports are filed with The Foursquare Church.
- Every restricted gift is recorded against the purpose stated by the donor.
- Spending is organized into cost centers: General Operations, Facility and Maintenance, Ministry, Events, Missions and Restricted Funds, Training, and Reimbursements.
- A receipt and a stated ministry purpose are required for every purchase, check, and transfer.
